### Neighborhood update

- 1. Knot Today is not performing today due to lead singer/bassist illness
- 2. Bulletin Board
  - Approved and installed by John. Donna contributed plexiglass.
  - Neighbors may post sale items and other info to build friendships and community; box is unlocked
  - Forms are in the mailbox for suggestions; Christine will check weekly
  - There might be a charge for business cards in the future (the Board will discuss); the backside of the Bulletin Board is open
- 3. Water update David Lagerlef
  - Aggregate water systems in TX have been consolidated and mask the rate increases for "improvements"
  - PUCT is trying to determine the validity of the increases in its meeting in June/July timeframe
  - Encouraged owners to write representatives
  - It was suggested to get a copy from Ken Watson of the Lake Limestone Water 10-year report and submit it to the state
  - · Could we own our own water system? Unlikely
  - It's not yet appropriate to hire a utility rate expert.
  - No one is checking meters
  - West Lake Limestone Fire Department partnership to get own well? Relationship with the Fire Department keeps changing. Go with ESD? Bob will pursue.

- 4. Navasota Electric maintenance getting better; trimming approaching be available to ensure aesthetics on your property.
- 5. Road Commissioner Sadler has been responsive; talk to him.
- 6. Marina sign light at LCR 740 & 937 burned out; pursue joint light with Post Oak? We'll need to investigate.
- 7. Tree concerns
  - Contact John Honey (property owner at the corner of LCR 740 & 743) about trimming back for road visibility. (Post meeting note: David Lagerlef made contact and received permission to trim, and trimmed shortly after our meeting.)
  - Contact the county for the trimming of roadway overhangs
